

Step 1: Connect your RADE Interface into the Vehicles OBD Port


The cable needs to be plugged into an OBD port of a vehicle. Once connected the RADE cable will proceed to start up. Please give the device time to complete the boot-up process before moving onto the next step. Once connected to the OBD port, the orange power LED will light up, your RADE device is now ready to use.



Step 2: Activate RADE's WIFI Module

The green light on the RADE device will then begin to flash slowly indicating that the devices' WIFI module is now online and ready to connect to a network. The RADE cable will emit its own Wi-Fi access point signal so that you can configure the tool.

Using either a smartphone, tablet, or computer, connect to the RADE Cables WIFI network, named Connector with the addition of the unique five-digit serial number located on the white sticker located on the underside of the device. EG. ConnectorXXXXX



Step 3: Connect RADE to your local WIFI


Once connected to the dedicated RADE WIFI network, open your browser and go to the <http://connector.help> website. You will be presented with a website where you can select your preferred WIFI network/Tethering hotspot that the RADE cable can find in range.

- When using iPhone hotspots you may need to toggle the hotspot setting on and off again to reactive the service
- Newer Android devices do not allow mobile hotspots and wifi to be enabled at the same time. In this case please use another device to configure your RADE cable to the mobile hotspot.



Step 4: Start using your RADE Cable

You will be disconnected from the ConnectorXXXXX WIFI network and your RADE will attempt to connect to the local network you selected in step 3. Once connected and registered with our servers the green light on the network port will stop flashing and become solid. Your RADE device is now ready to use!



Step 5: Logging into your RADE account

To login to your RADE account open your browser again and go to <https://r.a.d.e.obd.help/login> website. Here you will be asked to login using your email address and the password you created when you received the password setting email, enter your details and press login.

Step 6: Creating your first ticket

Once you have logged in to your RADE account you should be sent to the select OBD-II connector page. If your RADE has been correctly setup and connected to the internet it should show up here, the green symbol on the left indicates that the RADE is online.
